


Cell Notes: 1.10.17

Living like Jesus, having the attitude of Christ

Readings: Phillipians 2:1-13 Matthew 21:23-32



This picture is called Amen! By Koder. It goes with the verse from Lamentations “His yoke is on my neck, he has deprived me of strength”.

Q What does this picture make you think of when you look at it?

Q How do you think Jesus feels about the state of his church, the body of Christ? What is our role in society and do we live the way He calls us to live?

Q What do you love about being part of the body of Christ? What is hard about being part of this mission on earth?

Q Read Philippians 2:1-13. Discuss Christ's humility and what our response could be too that. Think of the things you already do and the possibilities that exist because of Christ's example to us in how we are to follow him.

Q Read Matthew 21:23-32. Matthew is primarily concerned with speaking to his fellow Jewish community, and helping them to see that Jesus is really the Messiah. With this in mind what do these passages tell us about how we could speak into areas outside the church who do not know who Jesus is yet? What was the message of John the Baptist Jesus refers to?

Reflection – God is totally in love with you, knows everything about you and longs for you to live in relationship with him. Spend some time thinking about how you please God, the things he loves that you do for him. Remember nothing is too small when motivated by love for God. Then spend some time asking God to speak to you as individuals and maybe even as a cell group about what he may be calling you to do for Him as His hands and feet on earth.
