NEW WINE DAY TICKETS

New Wine is a Christian festival held at the Bath and West Showground (only 40 mins away from Trowbridge). There are great opportunities for worship, teaching, fellowship and fun. **They have just released day tickets**, which cost £55 per adult. There are also tickets available for secondary school children (£40) who can attend Luminosity which is the programme specially intended for them. Tickets are available for younger children, but they are not able to join the children's groups. If you'd like to stay for longer, there are also tickets for the weekend (31st July to 2nd August) and for the whole festival (28th July to 2nd August) too. (Weekend tickets do not allow you to stay on site.)

Lyndsey and Simon W are Village Hosts in our camping village. They are inviting anyone from St Thomas to join them on **Wednesday 29th July**. They will meet you, show you where everything is and help you to get the best of everything from the day. They will provide a place to sit and chill with a hot drink and then dinner before the evening meeting.
